KEY SKILLS

Graduates of the programme will be capable of compiling analytical materials for assessing and making strategic decisions in the field of financial, economic and social activities using various sources of information, including full-text databases and economic, mathematical and statistical tools and will have learnt to:

- predict structural changes and trends in development of particular industries, countries and regions of the world;
- carry out efficient operational and strategic management of enterprises, as well as their economic, financial, marketing, personnel, production, and analytical subdivisions;
- develop and justify managerial decisions in the context of digitalisation of public life, based on the adopted social and economic guidelines.

The programme has been designed in cooperation with a foreign academic partner: Freie Universität Berlin (Germany). It offers an international educational environment and provides for a convenient schedule of classes in St Petersburg and Berlin. There are lectures by high-calibre Russian and foreign teachers. In the future, it might be implemented in the format of double diplomas.



MAIN COURSES

The master's programme is interdisciplinary. Students can choose to study in depth the economic systems of particular countries and regions. They can also specialise in political, sociological, historical, and international aspects of the performance of economic systems.

Lecturers from leading Russian and foreign universities, as well as representatives of government agencies, business and international economic organisations are regularly invited to deliver public lectures in order to deepen the internationalisation of the programme, improve the quality of education and its practical component.
