THE AIM OF THE PROGRAMME

The aim of this academic programme is to give students the insights into the phenomena of intercultural communication between German and Russian cultures with the focus on the challenges which are posed in teaching German as a foreign language and also to ensure a high level of intercultural competence of future experts involved in language and intercultural education.

The programme trains master's students whose professional activities will involve linguistics; language and linguistic education; culture and management. Graduates of the programme are ready to start a successful professional career as teachers of German as a foreign language in the sphere of additional education, at centres of the German language and culture and as higher school lecturers. Additionally, graduates can succeed in professional activities as experts in intercultural communication and mediation and philologists in scientific and publishing spheres.

The programme is designed for graduates from bachelor's programmes who are interested in the issues of intercultural communication, and who have the German language proficiency at level B2 + CEFR.



KEY SKILLS

Graduates of the programme will be able to:

- participate in the work of research teams conducting research into linguodidactic and linguistic issues, and prepare and edit scientific and instructional publications.
- plan and give classes of German as a foreign language and linguoculturology at institutions of general, secondary vocational and higher education; monitor and assess the quality of education; work out teaching materials for relevant courses; and effectively interact with all the participants in the teaching and learning process.
